



## NHS Regional Clinical Fellow Scheme Expanding development opportunities for aspiring clinical leaders

Experience leadership, service transformation, and improvement and equip yourself with the skills required to lead within complex, integrated systems of health and care.

## How does the scheme work?

Clinical leadership fellows will be based in NHS regional teams across England for 12 months from 1 September 2021. Posts are available less than full time and will be hosted by NHS England and NHS Improvement. The scheme is open to:

## doctors in training | dentists | pharmacists | allied health professionals nurses | midwives | healthcare scientists

Clinical fellows will lead key projects that contribute to regional and national priorities and will develop a range of skills in leadership, management, strategy, healthcare policy, commissioning, workforce and more.

The scheme is sponsored by NHS England and NHS Improvement and is managed by the Faculty of Medical Leadership and Management.

## How do I apply?

The scheme is open to qualified clinicians that hold full registration with the relevant professional body and are able to demonstrate experience at team leader level, equivalent to an NHS Band 7 role.
